# How to Become a Lifeguard/Swim Instructor for the City of Port Coquitlam

To be eligible to be employed as an Aquatic Leader with the City of Port Coquitlam, candidates must meet the following requirements.

#### Aquatic Leader Basic Requirements

Standard First Aid (Current within 3 years)
National Lifeguard - Pool Option
Water Safety Instructor
Minimum age of 16 years

Prerequisite
8-12 years
13 years of age or Bronze Star
Bronze Medallion
Recommended 14 years of age
16 years of age, Bronze Cross, Standard First Aid and CPR-C

Course	Prerequisite
Completion of Red Cross Swim Kids Level 10	No prerequisite
Water Safety Instructor	15 years of age and a Red Cross Swim Kids Level 10 ability +
Certified	Instructor

Candidates need to have completed all lifeguard and instructor certification to be eligible for employment with the City of Port Coquitlam.
